

## Authority:

the permission & power to make decisions

## Baptism:

the word means to dunk or dip in order to soak

#### Christ:

a title given to Jesus meaning 'special one', Saviour & Redeemer

#### Commission:

a task given to a person or a Group

## Disciple:

someone who follows Jesus, learning to become more like Him

#### Lord:

ruler, someone with authority, control & power; declares that Jesus is God

#### Pentecost:

the day the disciples received the Holy Spirit; the birth of the Church (see Acts 2:1-3)

#### Redeemer:

name given to Jesus meaning 'the one who pays the price for US'

### Repent:

to be sorry for something you've done wrong, to wish you hadn't done it & decide not to do it again; to turn away from something

#### Saviour:

name given to Jesus meaning 'the one who saves'

## Symbol:

something that points to (or represents) something else;

	something with a deeper meaning/importance
